# There are two applicable funds for Colombia

# **Darwin Initiative**

Supports projects for conserving biodiversity and poverty reduction activities in eligible countries.

# Illegal Wildlife Trade Challenge Fund (IWT Challenge Fund)

Provides funding for practical projects around the world that help eradicate illegal wildlife trade and, in doing so, reduce poverty.
